Eligibility

The scholarship application process is open to all <u>immediate</u> family members of current active (dues paid) members attending any accredited college, trade school, high school or grammar school. Immediate family is defined as, sons, daughters, step sons, step daughters and those who are members of a family by court decree (legal guardianship). Only one application per eligible student will be accepted. Undergraduate College will be awarded one time to one person. High school and grammar school shall be awarded no more than two times per applicant. All scholarship awards will be presented at GAPA'S January general membership meeting. Proof of enrollment / attendance is required for **all college** and **high school** winners. Proof of attendance will be verified by the scholarship committee prior to the presentation of the scholarship awards.
