GAPA/Rupert Mayer DANK German Language School Scholarship

The GAPA Board of Directors will granting a special, one semester scholarship (\$300) to a DANK North German language student. This scholarship will be awarded and based on an essay on Rupert Mayer, a Catholic priest who was an outspoken opponent of the 3rd Reich before and during World War II. Mayer, as a frontline chaplain, lost a leg

during WWI but was also awarded the Iron Cross for his services. Throughout this time he was arrested, beaten and imprisoned in Sachsenhausen concentration camp for his refusal to stop preaching against the Nazi regime. GAPA editor Mike Haas wrote a two part essay on Rupert Mayer in the Nov/Dec 2012 & Jan/Feb 2013 issues of the Brennpunkt (archived on our website) and proposed the scholarship to the GAPA Board. The

Board considers this is a worthwhile endeavor to demonstrate to our young people that despite all the anti-German sentiment since that time, there were people in Germany who courageously spoke truth to power in an incredibly treacherous time.
